In 2010 they built a brand new facility in Newport that allowed them to upgrade their equipment and build a beautiful visitors center to promote from. Some Local Consumption Stastics:

- Since 2001, the number of Farmers Markets in the US has tripled
- In 1986 there we 2 Community Supported Agricultural farms (CSAs). In 2005 there were 1000 CSAa and in 2009 there were over 2000 CSAs.
- Over 90% of the fine dining establishments in the US incorporate local ingredients into what they serve.

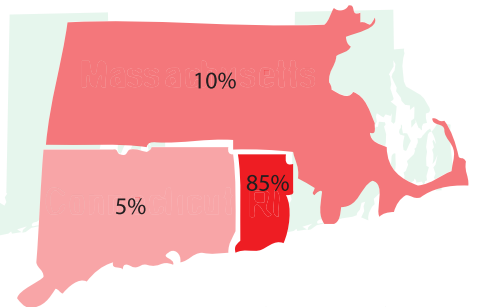


A 12-pack of Newport Storm Hurricane Amber Ale One of the Newport Storm beers which are 100% made in Newport, RI
